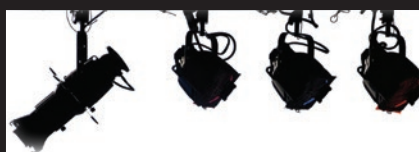

JESYCA CHUGG

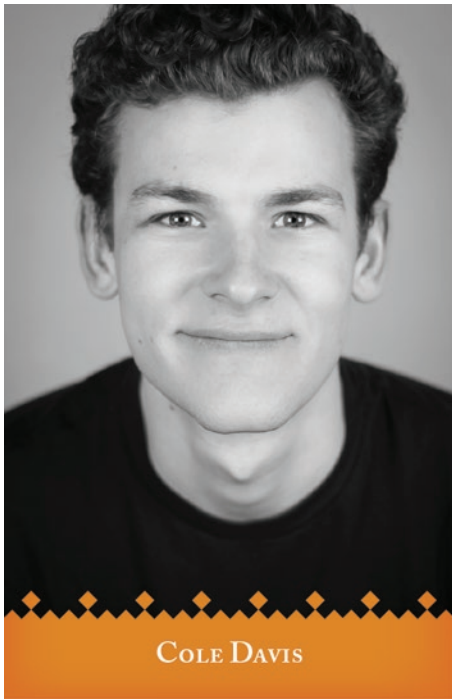
Child 3 (WT&S)

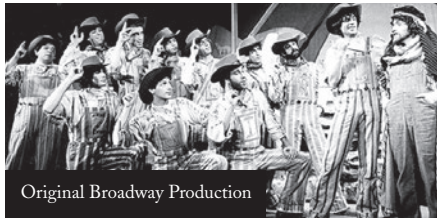

ABOUT THE SHOW

1. By 2008, more than 20,000 schools and amateur theater groups had produced "Joseph" This makes it the most performed musical in history.
2. "Joseph" was originally written as a "pop cantata" for a children's choir. Colet Court School in England commissioned a nineteen-year-old Andrew Lloyd-Webber to write it for their Easter end-of-term concert.
3. "Joseph" was sold by Andrew Lloyd Webber and Tim Rice to Novello and Co. for only 50 guineas (or about \$70) each. Lloyd Webber's Really Useful Group later bought it back for £1 million.
4. In the original Broadway run, Joseph's brothers wore striped overalls with their initials on their chest.

5. 1970's teen idol Andy Gibb played Joseph in the 1980's Broadway run.
6. In 2007, BBC One aired a reality TV show called Any Dream Will Do, where aspiring young actors competed to get the role of Joseph in the next production of the musical.
7. Elton John's Rocket Pictures is currently working on an animated feature film version of "Joseph" for its fiftieth anniversary.
8. The Islamic prophet Muhammad is believed to have said: "One half of all the beauty God apportioned for mankind went to Joseph and his mother; the other one half went to the rest of mankind."

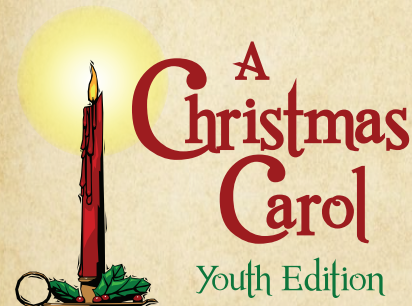
