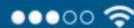

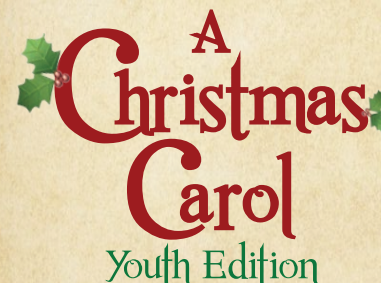

### ZACK HARRISON

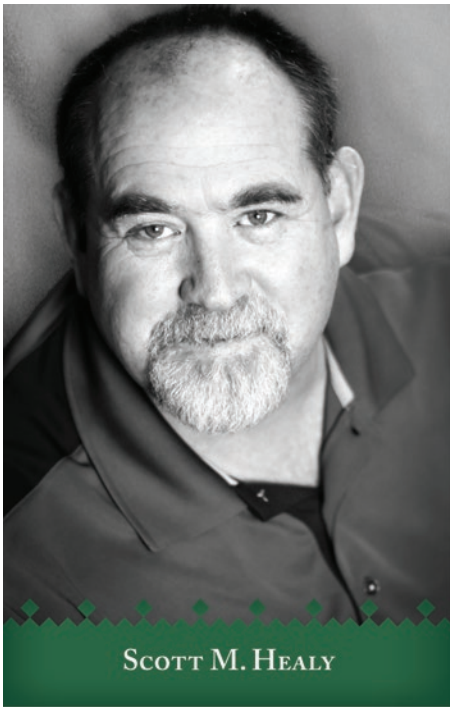
*Fred (MWF)*

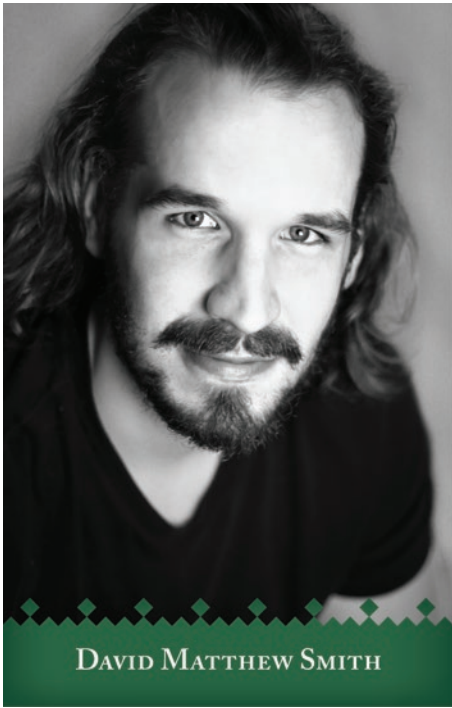

# INTERESTING FACTS

- 1 Dickens did not explicitly say what Tiny Tim's illness was. However, kidney failure or rickets have been tossed around as possible diagnoses. Either illness was treatable—but terminal if untreated—during Dickens' lifetime. This fits with the comment of the Ghost of Christmas Present that Tiny Tim would die only if the present remain unchanged.
- 2 A Christmas pudding is a fruitcake-like dessert made of sugar, suet, spices, brandy, fruit and nuts. It was steamed for many hours, wrapped in cloth, often in the very same copper basin that was used for laundry.
- 3 The treadmill was a form of engine typically powered by humans, and used to raise water, power cranes, and grind grain.

It was utilized in prisons as penal labor in the early Victorian period in Britain as a form of punishment.

- 4 "Dickens is responsible for Christmas as we know it. Christmas was barely celebrated at the start of the 1800s and December 25 was just a normal working day. The holiday was still suffering the effects of the Puritan era and was seen as a Pagan enterprise. The publication of *A Christmas Carol* added an emotional component to Christmas and changed it forever. We will never know what Christmas would be like without Charles Dickens, but it would never have been quite the same as we enjoy today without him."

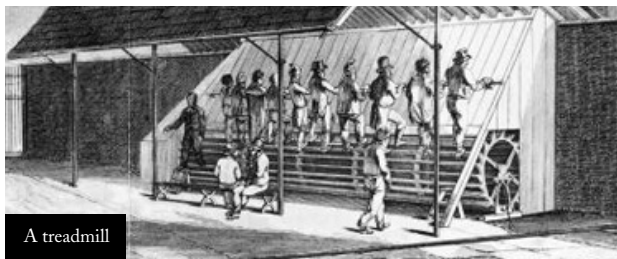
